

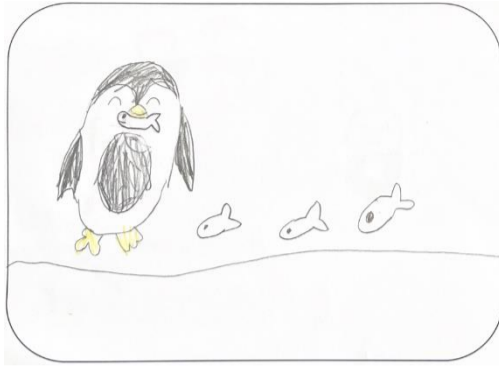

The animal I saw in Ocean Park was penguin. It has wings. It has a small head. It is black and white. It is cute. **(P1 Miaoer)**



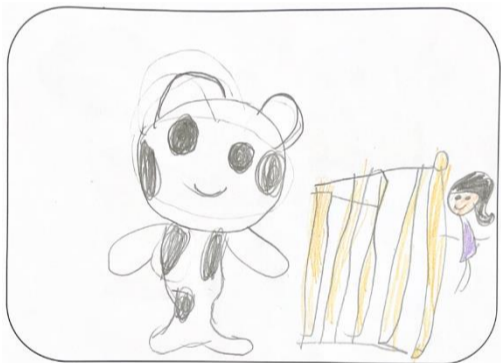
The animal I saw in Ocean Park was penguin. It is taller than my baby brother. **(P2 Yiu Yiu)**

The animal I saw in Ocean Park was penguin. It has a fat tummy and a long orange beak. **(P2 Giselle)**



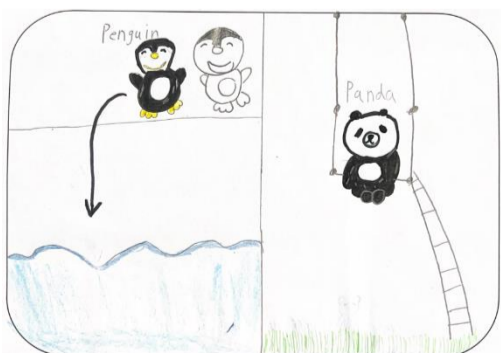
The animal I saw in Ocean Park was panda. The panda has big black eyes. It is black and white. It is cute. The panda is very big. **(P1 Oasis)**

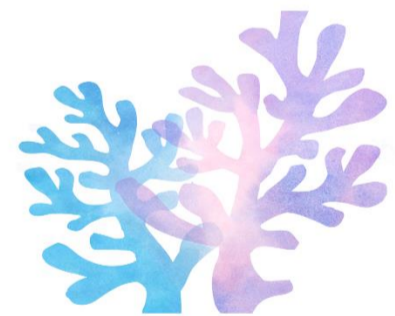
