Japan



A cherry blossom (or commonly known in Japan as sakura) is the flower of any of several trees of genus *Prunus*, particularly the Japanese cherry, *Prunus serrulata*.



Tokyo Tower is a communications and observation tower in the Shibakoen district of Minato, Tokyo, Japan.

At 332.9 metres (1,092 ft), it is the second-tallest structure in Japan.

The structure is an Eiffel Tower inspired lattice tower that is painted white and international orange to comply with air safety regulations.



Mount Fuji is one of Japan's "Three Holy Mountains" along with Mount Tate and Mount Haku.

It is also a Special Place of Scenic Beauty and one of Japan's Historic Sites.

Louvre Museum

In the former royal palace of French Kings, the Louvre is an incomparable museum that ranks among the top European collections of fine arts. Many of Western Civilization's most famous works are found here including the **Mona Lisa** by Leonardo DaVinci, the **Wedding Feast at Cana** by Veronese, and the 1st-century-BC **Venus de Milo** sculpture.



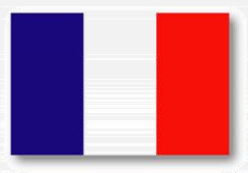
EIFFEL TOWER



The tower is 324 metres (1,063 ft) tall, about the same height as an 81-storey building, and the tallest structure in Paris. Its base is square, measuring 125 metres (410 ft) on each side.

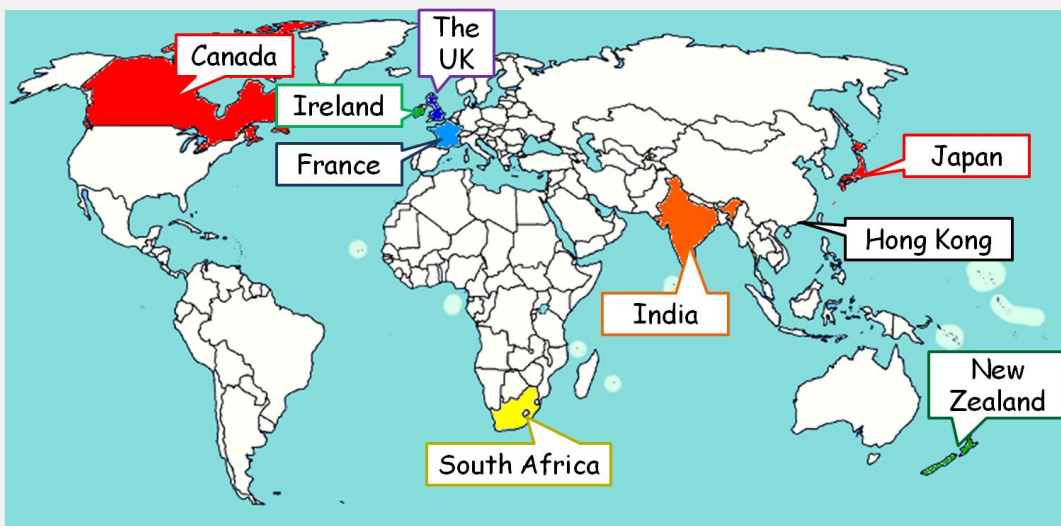
P6 Harriet reflected...

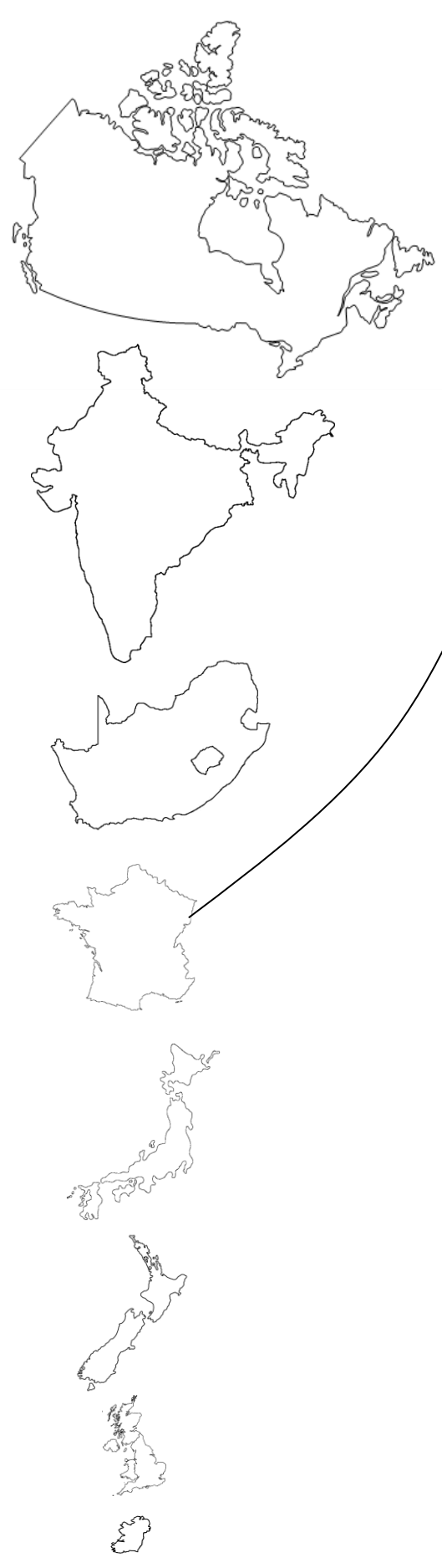
